Care Instructions:

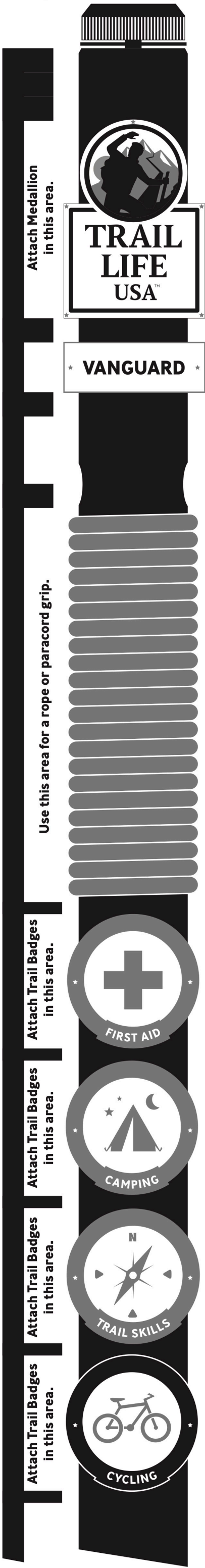
Please note that the following care instructions were provided to Trail Life by our Official Standard vendor.

- Store the standard(s) in a dry room.
- Keep the standard(s) away from direct sunlight.
- Store the standard(s) lying flat on the ground or lying flat on a shelf. Keep in mind that the standard(s) must always rest at their full length to avoid bending.
- Avoid wet rooms or rain as this may result in bending or splitting of the varnish.
- After outdoor use, wipe the standard(s) with a damp (not wet) cloth.
- Always check the tip before using. Change if necessary.
- Protect the standard(s) from falling over to prevent damage to the varnish.
- Never use the standard(s) without the screw thread protective cover.
- Keep the packaging material away from children and pets. Risk of injury.

Return Policy:

- All returns must be initiated within 30 days of receipt of the product.
- It is the customer's responsibility to inspect all merchandise **before use or storage** to ensure it is the correct merchandise, in new condition as ordered, and undamaged.
- The customer is responsible for all shipping charges unless the refund is due to a fulfillment or shipping mistake.
- Returns will not be accepted for merchandise that has been altered for any reason.
- Discontinued, promotional, discounted, and non-stock merchandise are not returnable.
- No cash or check refunds will be issued.
- Upon receipt by customer service, authorized returns in resalable condition will be issued a refund by customer service. **No exchanges!**
- Manufacturing defects, while rare, do occur. In these cases of defect, please contact Trail Life USA directly at **store@traillifeusa.com** within the 30-day return policy window. Prior to processing, we do require photographed evidence of defect for assessment and is needed for reimbursement from our distribution partner.

just hang them from a simple
cord. It's totally up to you!

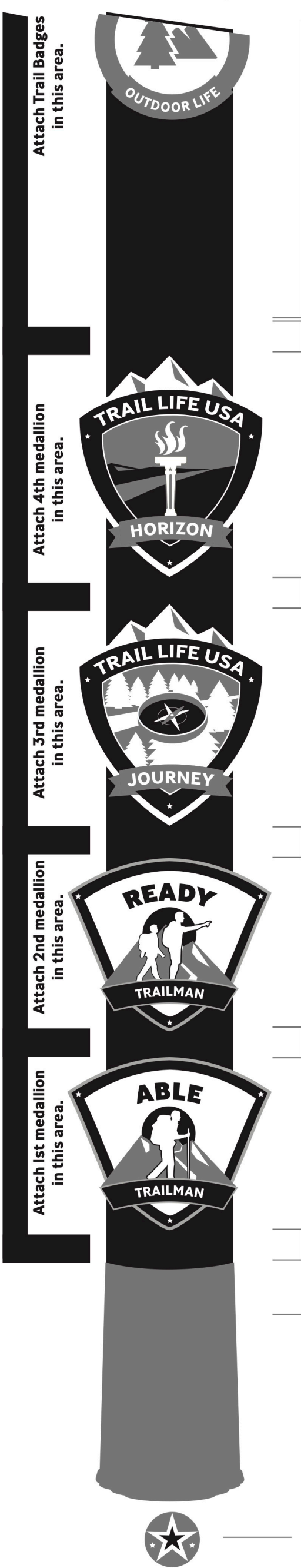

Step 1 - Lay Standard on template and use the spacing guides to determine placement. Peel glue backer and place medallion.

Step 2 - Place Standard on blanket or towel to protect surface and wood from damage.

Step 3 - Tap nails gently with hammer.

NOTE- Finish driving nails with a small flat tip punch to prevent damage from a hammer.
